



**EXTERNSHIP IN NEUROPSYCHOLOGY AND NEUROREHABILITATION  
CHILDREN'S SPECIALIZED HOSPITAL  
APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 2007**

The Department of Neuropsychology and Neurorehabilitation at Children's Specialized Hospital is pleased to offer an unpaid academic-year externship for graduate students involved in programs related to psychology and/or neurorehabilitation.

The Department is an outpatient facility that was developed as a service program for children with primarily acquired brain injury, ages 8 to 22, with an emphasis on assessment and treatment aspects of rehabilitative processes. Clinicians/staff endorse a holistic approach to rehabilitation that attends to the combination of cognitive, developmental, and psychosocial influences on the child's overall functioning and recovery.

Externs participate in many of the clinical facets of the Neurorehabilitation program, with a primary focus on learning theories and ways to develop and improve areas of neurocognitive functioning in children with acquired brain injury. Specific clinical experiences include leading/co-leading neurorehabilitation groups; coaching and providing strategies to individual students based on specific neurocognitive deficits; and conducting brief screenings to evaluate neurobehavioral functioning. Didactic (e.g., weekly Neuropsychology Training Seminars, etc.) and supervision experiences are required and incorporated into the trainee's schedule. Additional experiences vary based on specifics determined by requirements of the trainee's graduate school program. Interested applicants are required to submit a letter of interest and a resume for review. Interviews are scheduled thereafter.
