



New York Neuropsychology Group Student Research Award 2007

Submissions are now being accepted for the Annual NYNG Student Research Award. Applicants are encouraged to submit a one page abstract describing ongoing or completed research in the field of Neuropsychology.

Submissions can be posters or papers in submission, or those previously presented at state, national, or international conferences.

The recipient of the NYNG Student Research Award will receive \$250.

TO APPLY:

- Submit a cover letter with the title of your abstract, name of your institution, and year in program.
- Abstracts are limited to a one page, double-spaced description of the research.
- Applicant must be either:
 - enrolled in a doctoral program studying Neuropsychology
 - enrolled in a post-doctoral fellowship in Neuropsychology
- If the applicant is a student, the submission must also include a letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the student's program recommending the abstract and attesting to the fact that the student is in good standing.
- Abstracts should not include identifying information.

Abstracts will be judged based on originality and scientific value by the NYNG Education Committee. The recipient will be announced at the annual Arthur L. Benton Lecture and will present the study on which the abstract was based at a subsequent meeting in the NYNG Colloquium series.
