## **POSTDOCTORAL RESIDENCY IN NEUROPSYCHOLOGY**

---

The New York University (NYU) Comprehensive Epilepsy Center announces an opening for a postdoctoral residency position in clinical neuropsychology beginning on September 1, 2007. The neuropsychology resident will work with adults and children undergoing inpatient and outpatient work-ups for characterization and localization of cerebral dysfunction associated with intractable epileptic seizures. Clinical experiences include neuropsychological assessment, intracarotid amobarbital testing, and brain mapping. Additional inpatient and outpatient experiences with a wider range of neurological and/or psychiatric conditions are included. There is an opportunity for experience with cognitive remediation, particularly in a group format. The resident will take part in case conferences, teaching rounds, and various didactic experiences in the Departments of Neurology and Psychiatry at NYU Medical Center. There are opportunities for supervision of clinical interns and externs. The resident will also be expected to conduct an independent research project and collaborate on ongoing research protocols.

The two-year position carries a stipend of \$33,000 plus insurance benefits. Graduation from a doctoral program is required. Specialization in neuropsychology and completion of a neuropsychology internship is preferable. The application deadline is February 1, 2007. Selection of candidates will be conducted through the APPCN Resident Matching Program.
