



EXTERNSHIPS IN CLINICAL NEUROPSYCHOLOGY

The New York University (NYU) Comprehensive Epilepsy Center is recruiting clinical externs with an interest in neuropsychology for the 2007-08 training year. Selected externs will learn to administer, score, and interpret neuropsychological test batteries in adults and children undergoing inpatient work-ups for intractable seizures and other neurological conditions. Externs will attend case conferences, teaching rounds, and various didactic experiences in the Departments of Neurology and Psychiatry at NYU Medical Center. There will be opportunities to observe the intracarotid amobarbital procedure (Wada Test) and intracranial brain-mapping of language in surgical candidates. There is also an option for gaining research experience in ongoing investigations and for developing individual projects to meet requirements for master's degree or doctoral dissertation research.

The externship will begin on September 1, 2007 and extend through May 2008. There are also opportunities for intensive Summer experiences for interested applicants. Current enrollment as a doctoral student in Psychology is required. Graduate coursework in neuropsychology and prior testing experience is preferable. The application deadline is February 1, 2007.
